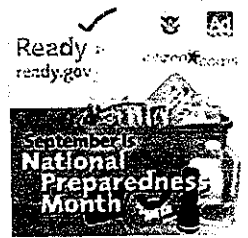


EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS QUIZ FOR KIDS – READY OR NOT?
